

NEFCU opens 18th branch

NEFCU, a Westbury-based credit union, opened its 18th branch last week. The high-tech branch, at 830 Fort Salonga Road in Northport, is NEFCU's fifth in Suffolk County and, similar to the credit union's other recently opened branches, it has less square footage than the traditional branches.

The 1,600-square-foot retail location, which was previously occupied by RadioShack, features NEFCU's Interactive Teller Machine technology, in which credit union members interact with tellers on video screens; the tellers are centrally located in NEFCU's Westbury headquarters. The branch is staffed with a team of member service representatives to assist customers with inquiries and account openings.

Employing ITM technology and smaller footprints has allowed NEFCU to expand more efficiently.

"We're proud to call Long Island home and we're excited to be able to put out more and more welcome mats throughout the Island," NEFCU Executive Vice President Eileen Nolan said in a statement.

NEFCU plans to open another branch, at 356 New York Avenue in Huntington, before the end of the year, which will mark its fourth new branch in 2018 and the sixth in the last two years.
